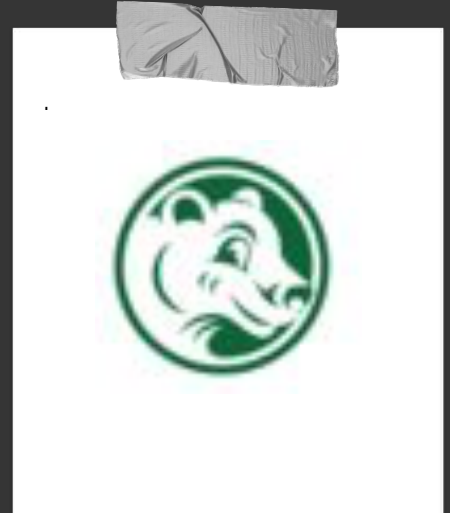
The Madrona Kids Fund Fundraiser was created as a way to give **100% of donated money back to our children's education.**

Madrona students are lucky in that they start instruments in the 4th grade. MIT allocates \$5,000 every year for the music teachers to hire professional musicians to offer guided help to students in class.



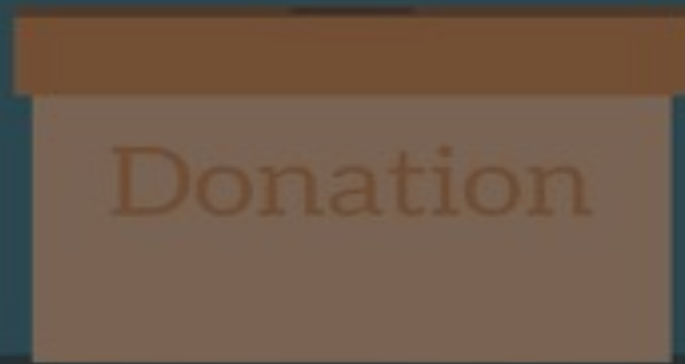
