- Madrona Kids Fund Maura D.: Description of funds allocations
 - Flyers distributed to kids, thanks to all who helped.
 - 100% of funds come back to our children's education; most school fundraisers take 40-60% of all profits
 - ~\$7300 donated so far, goes through Thanksgiving
 - An anonymous donor has agreed to match donations 1:1 for the first \$5K raised, will see if first \$10K can be matched
 - Suggested rate of donation = \$55/student/year
 - Additional ways to donate:
 - Fred Meyer, Amazon Smile, Box Tops, Office Depot/Max, Company/Corporate matching
- Madrona Giving Tree Julie L.: Watch for emails and notices regarding giving tree, cut-off time to be determined later.

 - o Income \$24,256.44
